We hope that you will discover our Centre using sustainable transport. As well as being on the city centre cycle network, the Universal 'U' bus stops right outside our Centre. We're only a few minutes walk from Madingley Road (Citi 4 and Park & Ride services) and Girton Road (Citi 5 and 6 services).

We advise anyone driving to the Centre to park at Madingley Road Park and Ride, which is free (for up to 18 hours) and only a 5-10 minute walk away. Parking charges in Eddington apply 8am-6pm Monday to Friday and 10am-5pm at weekends and public holidays. The majority of spaces have a maximum stay of 2 hours and no return within 1 hour, there are some spaces outside with a maximum stay of 4 hours. There is disabled parking on site for Blue Badge holders. Please note that users of on street parking must register their vehicle, and there is a kiosk available in the Centre foyer.
