Robyn Hitchcock

Robyn Hitchcock is one of England's most enduring contemporary singer/songwriters and live performers. A surrealist poet, talented guitarist, cult artist and musician's musician, Hitchcock is among alternative rock's father figures and is the closest thing the genre has to a Bob Dylan (not coincidentally his biggest musical inspiration).

Since founding the art-rock band The Soft Boys in 1976, Robyn has recorded more than 20 albums as well as starred in *Storefront Hitchcock* an inconcert film recorded in New York and directed by Jonathan Demme.

Blending folk and psychedelia with a wry British nihilism, Robyn describes his songs as "paintings you can listen to".



We hope that you will discover our Centre using sustainable transport. As well as being on the city centre cycle network, the Universal 'U' bus stops right outside our Centre. We're only a few minutes walk from Madingley Road (Citi 4 and Park & Ride services) and Girton Road (Citi 5 and 6 services).

We advise anyone driving to the Centre to park at Madingley Road Park and Ride, which is free (for up to 18 hours) and only a 5-10 minute walk away. Parking charges in Eddington apply 8am-6pm Monday to Friday and 10am-5pm at weekends and public holidays. The majority of spaces have a maximum stay of 2 hours and no return within 1 hour, though there are some spaces with a maximum stay of 4 hours. There is also disabled parking nearby for Blue Badge holders. Please notes that users of on street parking must register their vehicle, and there is a kiosk available in the Centre foyer.
