Anna Hester has a "powerful and confident voice" (Fatea, 2014), and moves "effortlessly between genres, but always with an emotional core" (Cambridge Music Reviews, 2018).

Anna Hester's debut album *Postcard Songs* came out in August 2021. *Postcard Songs* is the culmination of five years of creative work and collaboration, including a successful Crowdfunder campaign. The 10 songs all use postcards as a starting point, and together they tell a range of intertwining stories. The postcard project began in 2016 when Anna attended an Arvon songwriting retreat. She received guidance from tutors Kathryn Williams and Samantha Parton and guest speaker Boo Hewerdine. Inspired by the course, Anna set to work writing songs about postcards: about the images, the messages, and the people and places behind them.







We hope that you will discover our Centre using sustainable transport. As well as being on the city centre cycle network, the Universal 'U' bus stops right outside our Centre. We're only a few minutes walk from Madingley Road (Citi 4 and Park & Ride services) and Girton Road (Citi 5 and 6 services).

We advise anyone driving to the Centre to park at Madingley Road Park and Ride, which is free (for up to 18 hours) and only a 5-10 minute walk away. Parking charges in Eddington apply 8am-6pm Monday to Friday and 10am-5pm at weekends and public holidays. The majority of spaces have a maximum stay of 2 hours and no return within 1 hour, though there are some spaces with a maximum stay of 4 hours. There is also disabled parking nearby for Blue Badge holders. Please note that users of on street parking must register their vehicle, and there is a kiosk available in the Centre foyer.
